



## Science week - Competition

Dear Parent/Carer,

This week our school Science week will be held the week beginning 27th June 2022. To start the week we will be having a fun interactive assembly held by Jet Pack Jez from 'Mad Science'. Following this, each class will have a workshop session and complete some science based activities throughout the week. The British Science week theme this year is 'Growth', which our sessions will focus around.

Due to numbers, only 3 year groups will be able to attend the assembly with Jet Pack Jez in person. To decide who these year groups will be, we are running a competition. 3 lucky winners will win the opportunity for their Year group to attend the assembly. All other children will still take part in the assembly but this will be done virtually from their classroom.
