## Changes to Hours and Fees

Our fees and hours are changing. From the 30th October we will run the following preschool sessions;

Morning session 9.00-12.00 =£8

Afternoon session 12.00-3.00 =£8

Full Day 9.00-3.00 = £16

We will be asking fee paying parents to pay for all the sessions they have booked. If your child does not attend a session you will still be charged. This is due to staffing costs and the increasing demand for places. If you are unsure of the sessions you have booked then please speak to a member of staff.

#### School Meals Available!


Children that attend the afternoon session or full day will be able to order a hot school meal. These will be charged at £2.50 and will be payable via parentpay.
