Which is the hardest word on your list? Write it joined up 10 times, as fast as you can.

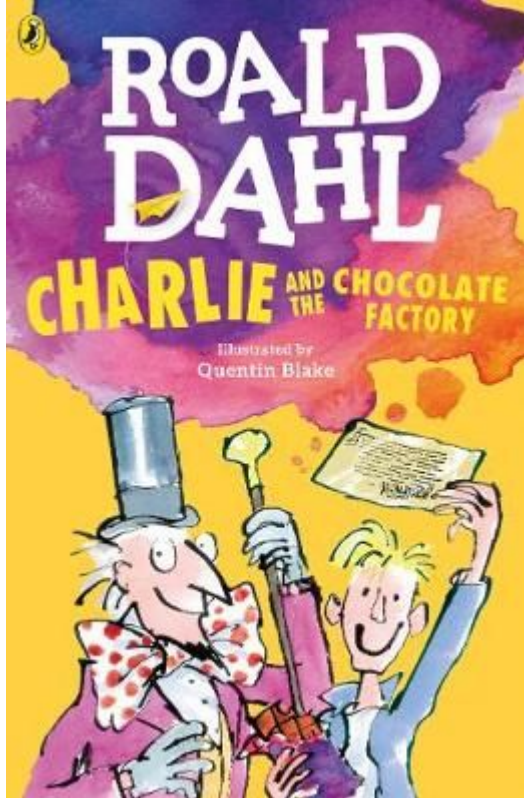
Then when you have finished, can you write the word backwards, starting with the last letter?
